(sUAS), loitering munitions, and ballistic missiles. Effective point defense (PD) is critical

for maintaining operational readiness and mission success in the future.

Participants' essays should address the following: Considering the responsibilities,

limitations, historical context, and emerging technologies regarding point defense, should

the USAF rely solely on organic Air and Missile Defense (AMD) capabilities, or focus on an

integrated joint force approach? Furthermore, how do point defense authorities and capabilities integrate and affect the Agile Combat Employment (ACE) scheme of

maneuver? Finally, are these issues adequately addressed or considered in joint and

service doctrine?

Essay submissions should explore innovative approaches that push doctrinal boundaries

and challenge conventional paradigms. Winning entries will be published and may

influence the development of future doctrine across the Air Force and Department of

Defense.
