Summary of Key Changes for AFDP 3-0, Operations

- Consolidated information from previous AFDP 3-0 and AFDP 3-30 to improve Airmen's understanding of airpower by describing the USAF functions and capabilities
 - -- Created AFDP 3-0.1, *Command and Control* as a separate publication to address an evolved understanding of command & control and mission command
- Re-designed the context for applying airpower by progressing through the competition continuum, uses of military power, and joint operations
- Included joint all-domain operations (JADO) information to eventually rescind AFDP 3-99, *DAF Role in Joint All-Domain Operations*.
- Strengthened airpower's connection with JP1 Vol 1, *Joint Warfighting* by connecting USAF capabilities to the Joint Warfighting Concept
- Refined airpower in joint operations by discussing the framework of campaigns, major operations, joint operations, and joint air operations
- Updated with relevant senior-leader quotations and vignettes on the Air Force Future Operating Concept (AFFOC) and Agile Combat Employment (ACE) to highlight emerging doctrine, operational concepts, and current issues
- Renamed effects-based approach to operations (EBAO) as "The Airman's Perspective" and moved to AFDP 5-0, *Planning*
