

Summary of Key Changes for AFDP 3-02, *Strategic Attack*

- Renumbered from AFDP 3-70 to AFDP 3-02 to elevate it to a more prominent position within Air Force operational doctrine
- Clarified the Fundamentals of Strategic Attack to accurately characterize its distinctiveness
- Aligned Strategic Attack and strategic objectives language with Joint Publication (JP) 3-0, *Joint Campaigns and Operations* and AFDP 3-72, *Nuclear Operations*
- Updated Command and Control of Strategic Attack to align with AFDP 3-0.1, *Command and Control*
 - Outlines requirements and authorities for subordinate commanders to conduct the C2 process in Strategic Attack
 - Included Strategic Attack C2 Activities
- Added Forcible Action as a strategic use of military force in the competition continuum to accompany coercion to align with JP 1 Vol 1, *Joint Warfighting*
- Removed effects-based approach to operations and replace with the effects-based and objectives-based principles of targeting
- Refreshed organization of the publication
 - Removed detailed description of the joint planning process for air
 - Updated “Blue Box” vignettes with more current Strategic Attack examples
 - Incorporated the descriptions of kinetic/non-kinetic from AFDP 5-0, *Planning*, and lethal and nonlethal effects from JP 3-60, *Joint Targeting*
