- Eliminated tactical execution details related to command and control conflicts for unmanned aerial systems during ISR and close air support taskings
- Removed redundant text explaining close air support mission types and the roles of a FAC(A) and TAC(A)
- Clarified doctrine related to the execution of air interdiction operations within a kill box short of the fire support coordination line (FSCL)
- Adjusted 'tone' and updated terminology to reflect the current DoD dictionary
- Added/updated hyperlinks to appropriate primary source documents as required
