Summary of Key Changes for AFDP 3-13, Information Operations

- Title changed to AFDP 3-13, *Information in Air Force Operations*
 - Better aligns with the JP 3-04, *Information in Joint Operations*, 14 Sep 22
- Added Information Warfare (IW) as a USAF service term as developed in AFDP 3-99
 - Joint doctrine does not recognize IW as used by the service, only traditional and irregular warfare; this is quoted in JP 3-04 and highlighted in AFDP 3-13
 - Per the 3 Nov 22 AF Doctrine Writing Committee, the majority of IW language associated with force employment and presentation was removed from the document to accommodate further policy development by HAF and 16AF
- Added Information Warfare Forces as a USAF service term, aligning with language in JP 3-04
- Re-designated Information Operations Forces as a USAF service term; IO is rescinded as a joint term in JP 3-04
- Removed Information Related Capabilities (IRC) as a term; rescinded as a joint term in JP 3-04
- Adopted Operations in the Information Environment (OIE) to describe joint information operations in line with joint terminology
- Coordinated the Space Operations section with USSF Doctrine; aligns with language in Space Capstone Publication
- Adjusted 'tone' as necessary to emphasize IW as an air component commander capability and a service term; OIE or "information forces" is used when discussing the joint capability
- Hyperlinks to appropriate primary source documents were added/updated as required
- Terminology was updated to reflect the current DOD dictionary and system names; several substantive changes to this AFDP were created by the updates
