Summary of Key Changes for AFDP 3-14, Space Support:

- Changed the title of the document from Counterspace Operations to Space Support to properly reflect the change in space roles and missions from the US Air Force to the US Space Force (USSF).
- Updated the understanding of the Air Component Commander's role in supporting space operations through a supporting CCDR under the new USPACECOM and USSF role as outlined in the Unified Command Plan.
- Described USSF Guardian warfighter perspective, roles, responsibilities, and key terminology to better facilitate communication between the components.
- Described Air Force support to USSPACECOM through the Offensive Ops, Defensive Ops, EMSO, ISR, and Sustainment mission areas to better focus air component staff support.
- Described USSF support to the air component through PNT, SATCOM, EW, and ISR.
- Discusses the revised command relationships between the Air Component Commander, Space Component Commander, and CDRUSSPACECOM to ensure proper understanding of authorities.
- Identified the most applicable planning and execution considerations for USAF planners when supporting space operations or requesting space support under the new structure.
- Updated the list of relevant United States space law and policy documents for quick reference by air component staff.
- Updated terminology to reflect the current DOD dictionary and changes from JP 3-14, *Joint Space Operations*.
- Updated all hyperlinks to appropriate primary source documents as required.
