SUMMARY OF KEY CHANGES TO AIR FORCE DOCTRINE PUBLICATION (AFDP) 3-52, AIRSPACE CONTROL

- Publication reformatted from doctrine topic module structure to book format; publication was shortened from 71 pages to 61
- Content was condensed to reduce redundancies in information (specifically regarding chapters 4-7)
- Updated Foreword was inserted as approved by LeMay/CC
- Logical structure of the pub was shifted from an organization around the phases of joint operations and the complete range of military operations to one built around the competition continuum, near peer competition, and operations in contested, degraded environments
- Hyperlinks to appropriate primary source documents added/updated as required
- Footnotes updated/corrected as required
- Terminology updated to reflect the current DOD dictionary and system names
- Clarified language regarding coordination measures (CMs) and the airspace control authority
 - -- Updated with a more accurate description of how CMs are established and the chain of command for CM requests.
- At JA's request, updated language from "major combat operations" to "large-scale combat operations" to match joint terminology reflected in JP 3-0
- At JA's request, inserted language clarifying the two types of airspace recognized by international law: international and territorial
