

**SUMMARY OF KEY CHANGES TO
AIR FORCE DOCTRINE PUBLICATION 3-60, *TARGETING***

- Changes kinetic and non-kinetic references to coincide with “capabilities” and lethal and non-lethal references to coincide with “effects” throughout.
- Changes targeting as a planning process to “deliberate targeting.”
- Changes the means of serving targets to “deliberate or dynamic targeting.”
- Adds discussion clarifying the relationship between target lists and the no strike list.
- Moves “Targeting Automation” doctrine topic module to Appendix B.
- Updates and clarifies the discussion in “Targeting Fundamentals.”
- Removes “Effects Based Approach to Operations;” refers to Annex 3-0 for same info.
- Includes discussion of targeting across the competition continuum.
- Updates and refines the discussion in “Introduction to Targeting,” “Targeting Fundamentals,” “Targeting Cycle,” “Command and Organization,” “Targeting and Targeting Related Responsibilities,” “Establishing Collaborative and Support Targeting Relationships,” “Targeting Planning,” “Deliberate Targeting,” “Dynamic Targeting,” “Basic Principles of the Law of War and Their Targeting Implications,” “Law of War Targeting Restrictions,” and “Air Force CONUS Organizations,” and “Joint and National CONUS Organizations” sections of the publication.
- Updates organizations in Appendix C, “Reachback and Federated Support to Targeting and Assessment.”
- Updates publication to chapter book format, removing doctrine topic modules.
- Updates terminology, abbreviations, and all hyperlinks throughout.
