

Summary of Key Changes for AFDP 3-84, *Legal Support*.

- Overall reorganization to begin publication with JA structure and fundamentals, then transitioned into how JA supports air operations, and ending with a focus on rules of engagement and rules for use of force through the lens of operational planning
- Re-emphasized TJAG's role and authorities under federal law and the ability of JAs to provide independent legal advice to commanders without interference
- Incorporated USSF throughout the publication and added USSF doctrine reference link
- Added Nuclear Operations to the Mission Specific Judge Advocate Support section
- Highlighted required State Department and SECDEF coordination and approval for host nation negotiations
- Updated discussion points under claims jurisdiction, responsibility, and processing
- Consolidated multiple grammar inputs to provide clarity for the reader
- Updated Appendices and added additional information to fully develop resources, authorities under the law, and essential tasks performed by JA in planning and execution
- Added/updated hyperlinks to appropriate primary source documents as required
