

SUMMARY OF REVISION TO DOCTRINE ANNEX 4-02, *HEALTH SERVICES*

Summary of Key Changes: 12 November 2019 – Formal Revision

- ★ Re-titled annex to better align with Joint Publication 4-02, *Joint Health Services*.
- ★ Text added to reflect implementation of NDS emphasis on peer/near-peer competition in a contested environment to attain and maintain a desired degree of global medical readiness.
 - ★★ Addressed need for health services to be adaptive, resilient, and agile as we continue to improve our medical capabilities and revolutionize health services.
 - ★★ Added new information on chemical, biological, radiological, and nuclear environment considerations.
- ★ Clarified Air Force roles in global medical readiness.
- ★ Updated *Appendix C: Roles and Responsibilities of Medical Agencies* to capture newly formed Air Force Medical Readiness Agency.
- ★ Consolidated *Command and Organization; Organization, Command, and Control; and Air Forces Objectives* DTMs into *Roles and Responsibilities* DTM to provide better clarity and brevity on leadership roles and responsibilities.
- ★ Added new information on *Health Surveillance* and *Patient Movement System*.
- ★ Restructured annex content flow to better align with Joint Publication 4-02.
- ★ Updated definitions and acronyms throughout annex.
- ★ Adjusted ‘tone’ as necessary.
